

# Denver ARES Weekly Net Script

{Pre-announce at 5 minutes before the net}

Attention all stations: this is this is **\*\*\*CALL SIGN\*\*\***, the weekly Denver ARES Region Ten, District Four Radio Net will begin in 5 minutes on this frequency.

{At Start of Net}

Attention all stations: this is the Denver ARES , Region Ten, District Four Radio Net, serving the City and County of Denver, Colorado.

This is **\*\*\*CALL SIGN\*\*\***, and I am serving as Net Control Station for the Denver ARES weekly net. I am located in **\*\*\*City\*\*\***, Colorado and my name is **\*\*\*NAME\*\*\***.

This is a directed Net conducted by Denver ARES. This Net is held each Tuesday at 1900 Mountain Time on a repeater frequency of 146.670 MHz with a PL tone of 100 Hz, courtesy of the Castle Rock Repeater Group with a backup frequency of 147.210 MHz also with a PL tone of 100 Hz, courtesy of Denver Water. If both repeaters are down, our Simplex Frequency is: 147.480 Mhz.

This net is open to ARES members and all licensed amateur radio operators with an interest in Emergency Communications, or who want to learn more about the Amateur Radio Emergency Services referred to as ARES.

Please, do not use “Q” signals or 10 codes and use standard ITU phonetics if needed.

All stations checking in are requested to remain on frequency until dismissed by Net Control. At this time, please check in clearly stating your call sign, name, location and indicate if you have any traffic. Please call Now.

I acknowledge (**list checkins**). Are there any corrections?

Acknowledge corrected call signs.

Let's continue with checkins: At this time, please check in clearly stating your call sign, name, location and indicate if you have any traffic. Please call Now.

I acknowledge (**list checkins**). Are there any corrections?

**\*\*PAUSE\*\***

**\*\*Callsign\*\*** has stated that you have traffic.

When when traffic is finished, ask if there are any questions, and after answering please return control to Net Control.

For each station:

(Call the station), please go now.

**\*\*PAUSE AFTER LAST TRAFFIC IS HANDLED \*\***

Are there any stations that would like to check in at this time?

**\*\*PAUSE\*\***

{If the EC has Checked In}

We will now turn the net over to **\*\*\*EC's Call Sign\*\*\***

**{When EC has returned Control to NCS}**

Are there any additional announcements, comments, or discussions for the net? Please call now. **\*\*PAUSE\*\***

Are there any stations that would like to check in before we close the net?

- and the Colorado Section VHF Net Held on Sunday Evening at 20:00 on the Colorado Connection Statewide linked repeaters.
